Review/Approve July Minutes:

July minutes were reviewed and a couple of typos were noted by Sue. Jessica made a motion to approve with corrections Denise provided the second. The minutes were approved by members in attendance.

Treasurer's Report:

The Treasurer's Report was provided by Denise and account balances were recorded on the Secretary/Club minutes copy. If anyone needs any information about the accounts please let me know or contact Denise directly. Denise lets us know that the Santa Cruz County Fairgrounds still has not cashed our club check for our spring show. Linda made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report and Jessica provided the second. Motion approved and carried.

Open Program Old and New Business:

Plans are indeed shaping up for our second 2016 Open Show date scheduled for August 27th at Watsonville. This all breed open show welcomes all levels and Denise has received several inquiries already. We have most of the major work assignments (gate, announcer, ring steward, office help, trail crew) filled with extra bodies volunteering for help. Sue will send an email out to members right before the show letting them know what time to be at the Fairgrounds for trail set up on Friday afternoon. Virginia and Sherry Barnard both confirmed with Nelly at the Fairgrounds that the CSHA deposit was applied for our Saturday show so we are confirmed for the 27th. Sherry is also contacting a food vendor to attend from at least 11 to 2 PM do get everyone through lunch. The clubs will bring/have water, coffee, donuts and other breakfast goodies on hand for the early morning. Jacqueline has spent a lot of time in connecting with trainers, stables and other horse venues via email and Facebook to make them aware of our upcoming show. Jacqueline is creating an "Events Page" for us on Facebook to help get the word out. Jacqueline will also be setting up a "giveaway table" with horse supplies and other items donated by vendors and private parties for giveaway gifts at the show.

CCC Program Old and New Business:

Our 7CPHC CCC Show at Brookside on September 21 – 25 is also gearing up. Members need to let Diane know what hours and what job they will be working as early as possible. Trail will be setting up Monday evening 9/19. Diane let us know that the host hotel for the show is the Holiday Inn at Rancho Cordova.

Diane mentioned the next CCC State meeting is coming up soon and for us to think about "Horseman of the Year" nominations. Diane also let us know that our club's 2017 show with Sierra PHC is tentatively scheduled for 11/8-12 at Rancho. Everyone is waiting for the Bakersfield Club to determine if they want to keep their October date or not. If Bakersfield passes on October, 7CPHC/Sierra may be able to switch their show date to October. Diane mentioned that the Temecula club has not determined their show dates and that they still owe their CCC State assessment payment as well as other fees. All show dates will be finalized by the end of the upcoming CCC meeting of which both Diane and Denise will be attending on our club's behalf. Lastly, beginning in 2017, Diane reminded us the APHA will be holding the Amateur World Show in September. The Youth World Show will continue to be held in July.

Other Business: There was no other business to be discussed.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:53 PM with a motion made by Jessica and a second provided by Linda with the club all voting in favor. Meeting was adjourned.
